Art Exploration 1-3 (Grades 1-3) \$15.00

Each week students will try out a different art medium such as watercolor, clay, collage, plaster of paris painting, and oil pastels. We will discuss a different technique each class and then complete a project related to the technique. All materials will be provided.

Arts and Crafts K-2 (Grades K-2) \$20.00

We will be learning about a variety of art mediums and making artwork or a craft to take home from each class. Students may want to bring a smock to wear. All supplies provided.

Ballet for Beginners (Grades 1-6) \$25.00

Your child or children Will Learn ballet dance & technique. They will Learn a Fun Recital by the End of the semester. Please bring a water bottle. You can purchase pink ballet shoes at Target or get them at Walmart-they have a slipper shoe that looks close enough & comfortable,- if You can find it & as long as it's pink.Wear leggings or stretchy pants.

Country Studies (Grades 1-3) \$20.00

We will "fly" around the world exploring and learning about different countries. We will learn about their flags, governments, famous landmarks, cultures, food, weather, and more. (Please let me know if there are any food allergies.)

Cupcake Creations (Grades 9-12) \$10.00

We will be decorating cupcakes, with different themes and techniques featured each week. We will be doing some decorating with a pastry bag, some without. All supplies will be provided for the class.

Elementary music (Grades 1-6) \$35/\$27 returning with recorder

This class will incorporate singing, instrument exploration, and recorder. We will have fun singing rounds, learning rhythms, note reading, composers, and so much more! We will also prepare some music to perform (performance information to be determined). If you have taken Recorder with me before and still have your folder and recorder you get a discounted price. All new students will receive a folder, music, and a Gia soprano recorder which will be needed for all classes. For those requesting Chorus, this is the class for you!

Escape Room (Grades 7-12) \$8.00

Get 'locked' into a room and figure out the clue to solve the mystery or successfully 'escape' the room.

Fermentation (Grades 7-12) \$40 (siblings can share)

Learn the art of fermentation! What happens during the fermentation process? What are the health benefits? Together, we'll make kombucha, fermented salsa, yogurt, and sourdough starter. Students will bring home their ferments and may be asked to burp or feed them when appropriate. Several classes will involve chopping of vegetables.

Fitness 101 (Grades 4-8) \$20.00

Children will learn different fun exercises. Please bring a water bottle.

French (PreK-K ages 3-5) \$10.00

Learn French through storytelling, songs, and games. This will be an interactive class where students will be introduced to the French language in a fun and engaging way.

Games for learning and fun Grades 1st-4th (Grades 1-4) \$15.00

Gym Pre K/K (PreK-K ages 3-5) \$8.00

Pre K/K gym. Games and movement activities to develop large motor skills and get the wiggles out.

Hands on Science Lab (Grades 7-12) \$20.00

Students will learn how to use the scientific method to formulate a hypothesis, perform hands-on experiments, observe and test their results to analyze their findings. Students will work together in smaller groups. Students will be required to record their findings and a lab report should be created for each experiment done in class. The experiments done in this class will be in the field of Earth Science. This class may include some small homework assignments.

Intro to charcoal drawing (Grades 7-12) \$25.00

We will learn how to use charcoal Hard and soft as a medium for drawing. A kit with both soft and hard charcoal is needed for this class. I will provide All other supplies needed. Here is a link to the kit I will have

Kitchen Science (Grades 2-4) \$15.00

Let's do some chemistry in the kitchen! Using common household items, curiosity and observation we will conduct experiments and make fun projects. We will even do some edible

Lego Robotics (Grades 4-6) \$28.00

We will use Legos, motors and sensors along with the Lego WeDo 2.0 programming software to make Lego creations come to life. Projects will offer a real world application and will challenge students to use creative problem solving skills to model reality and conduct experiments. Materials will be provided for the class.

Literacy and Math Centers (PreK-K ages 3-5) \$30.00

These classes will be organized as a block covering two periods. Your child will stay for both periods - no need to pick up between periods. Half of the kids will start in literacy centers and half in math and then switch. Literacy concepts will cover letter recognition, letter sounds, sequencing, listening comprehension, beginning writing, rhyming, and more. Math concepts will include shapes, sorting, patterning, number recognition, counting, measurement of length and weight, and money. Concepts will be introduced in fun ways that students can then explore and practice in a variety of centers. There will be opportunities for children to eat a snack if they choose (children need to bring their own).

Math Masters (Grades 1-3) \$15.00

Every week we will learn a new game that uses problem solving, Math or Logic. This class will reinforce Addition, Subtraction, Time, Money and introduce fractions, reasoning, probability, estimation, puzzles and edible Math. This class will be all about playing! We may also do some arts and crafts or make and take home games. Parents, please consider donating any unused math manipulatives, puzzles or appropriate materials (dice/clocks/measurement tools)

Music & Movement (PreK-K ages 3-5) \$16.00

Rhythm sticks, parachute, a carnival of animals and more! We will explore instruments of all sorts, and above all have fun with music!

Nursery Rhyme Time (PreK-K ages 3-5) \$10.00

Using skits, dress-up, crafts and songs we will visit the timeless world of make believe! We will learn many classic nursery rhymes with a focus on oral language skills and phonics.

Piano for Beginners (Grades 4-12) \$35.00

Children will Learn notes, theory, & application. Will have two regular size keyboards. If you already have your own please bring it in. You can purchase on-line a \$10.00 small keyboard, or a \$26.00 regular size keyboard. I will Supply the books Needed & tabletop easel unless You have one already. Your child will learn the basic notes, keys & songs as he or she continues to practice from Christian based piano books.

Ready, Set, Throw !!!! (Grades 1-3) \$20.00

Children will Learn many Fun Games !!! Please have your child or children bring a water bottle.

Rock Painting (Grades 4-6) \$20.00

Each week your child will be able to paint their rock using a chosen theme or their own creative ideas. Some paint techniques will be discussed so they can grow as artists. Your child will also learn about art concepts such as the color wheel, primary and secondary colors.

Show & Tell (PreK-K ages 3-5) \$10.00

Show & Tell a new favorite each week based on a theme.

Show and Tell (Grades 1-3) \$10.00

This class will introduce public speaking to your child. Your child will be excited to bring in and share their favorite items related to certain themes and their own free choice! They will also learn to become good listeners, ask appropriate questions, take turns and provide support for the other students.

Show and Tell K-2 (Grades K-2) \$10.00

A fun class where students will practice their speaking and listening skills with a different theme each week

Speak Up! (Grades 7-12) \$30.00

This is a public speaking class with a logic element added. We will be discussing common fallacies, practice common public speaking methods, and have some fun with a debate for the last class. This does require some homework on the part of the students who will have a speaking assignment each week.

Stop Motion Story Creation (Grades 4-6) \$18.00

In this class we will collaborate to write a group story, plan the look of the story and shoot and develop a stop motion mini movie.

Story Time (PreK-K ages 3-5) \$15.00

Story time will include a snack, read aloud, stretches, singing and dance! Let's recharge together with some story time and then shake those wiggles out! Snacks will be provided for the class unless your child has dietary restrictions. I would be more than happy to accommodate or feel free to pack your child their own (peanut free) snack. Don't forget to pack your child a pre-filled water bottle for class.
